Exams are proctored virtually, students test from home.

WHAT IS CREDIT-BY-EXAM (CBE)?

Students can earn credit for courses in which they demonstrate mastery of course material by taking the course exam(s). ASI offers a variety of options for CBE.

CBE does not satisfy the NCAA core course requirement.

- Tests can only be taken one time per subject.
- All exams are computer-based and will be taken online.
- CBEs are not considered Honors credit.
- Students must earn a 70% on the CBE to earn credit.
- Grades are posted with the letter grade to reflect the percentage scored.
- Failed tests are not posted to the student's transcript.

- Mathematics: Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry
- Social Studies: US Government & Economics, US History, World History
 English/Language Arts: English 9, English 10, English 11, and English 12
- World Languages: Spanish I, Spanish II, French I, French II
